PERSONAL NOTES

 National churches everywhere are facing many health and medical problems due to poverty, isolation, persecution, and lack of resources. John and Elizabeth are training national Christians to be health workers, serving in their churches and reaching out into their communities. The Sextons have served with MTW for over 25 years using their advanced nursing degrees, first in the jungle of Peru and then in Mexico, where they used community development projects as an outreach to help plant churches. Since 2003, John and Elizabeth have served globally with MTW's medical and health ministries in more than 25 countries.

Their projects and trainings are unique to the churches' specific needs. For example, in Southeast Asia, John trained volunteers to recognize, treat, and prevent common illnesses like malaria. In West Africa, John trained seminary students to be health teachers to prevent Ebola and other diseases. The churches use these skills to share Christ with people who would otherwise be closed to the gospel.

Another passion John and Elizabeth share is ministering to Native Americans. These are truly the "forgotten people." The Sextons minister spiritually through family conferences and home visits dealing with needs such as alcohol, drugs, family violence, and other issues facing these families.

THE SEXTON'S CURRENT UPDATE:

Thank you for your prayers about Montana Reserve in Maskwacis.

We did see God's hand the whole week. We have always had our conference in the Band Office (the Band's place of government). On Sunday, a prominent person in the community passed away. In respect, the office closes down and a 1-3 day wake and then funeral occurs in the Band Office.

Even the school often closes. The leaders of the reserve could have told us to cancel the conference out of respect to the person who passed away, but they were very strong that we should continue.

We could not have the conference in the Band Office so they got permission to have it in the school.

- The children' and the youth's programs went very well. Elizabeth had more help this year than before. There were three ladies for each program.
- We arrived home on Saturday night, and we leave this evening for Haiti. It is a medical team primarily from our home church along with three others from other parts
- . Elizabeth and I both get to go. She has been asked to prepare topics on women's health. This is a first attempt in Haiti, so she is preparing a long list of resources and topics in hope that women will be willing to come together for teaching.
- I will be seeing patients and following up with the Haitian nurse I helped train in the past in hypertension.
- Haiti, more than many other countries we visit, can be chaotic with sudden changes in logistics.

Please pray for:

- Elizabeth as she works with the women
- For us as we follow up with the nurse that we would be encouraging to her
- That we will minister both physically and spiritually to the people
- That the team would stay healthy

We continue to thank you for all you do for us.


